


Administrative burdens are a main reason to switch jobs



The study



Representative survey (n = 1.073)

- Find out what teachers consider administrative tasks
- Find out how teachers experience administration



Time measurements at 43 schools, by 256 teachers


- Find out how much time teachers spend on administration
- Explain differences between teachers



23 semi-structured interviews


Find out origin, purpose and use of administration

Most administration is directly connected to teaching




Teachers spend almost a day per week on administration

On average, administrative tasks cost teachers 6 to 8 hours/week




Organizing extra support for students takes a lot of time



Average time spent on administrative tasks per week

National law plays an indirect role in administrative burden



Teachers understand the purpose, but still feel the burden

- Teachers understand why they have to do their administrative tasks
- Administration is not simply filed away, but is heavily used in and around schools
- However: all administration combined takes too much time and leads to teachers leaving education, or getting overworked
